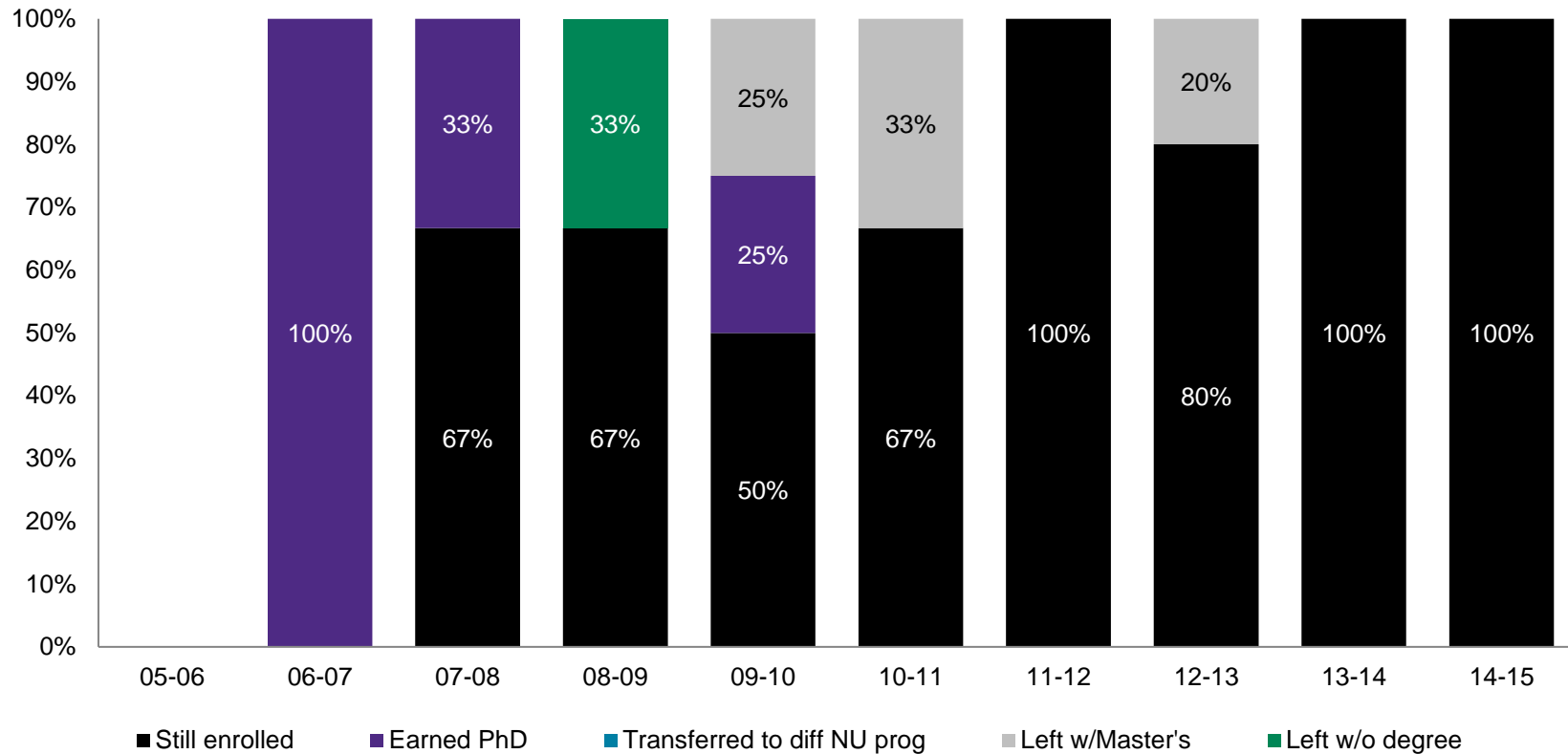

PhD program in African American Studies was created in fall of 2006

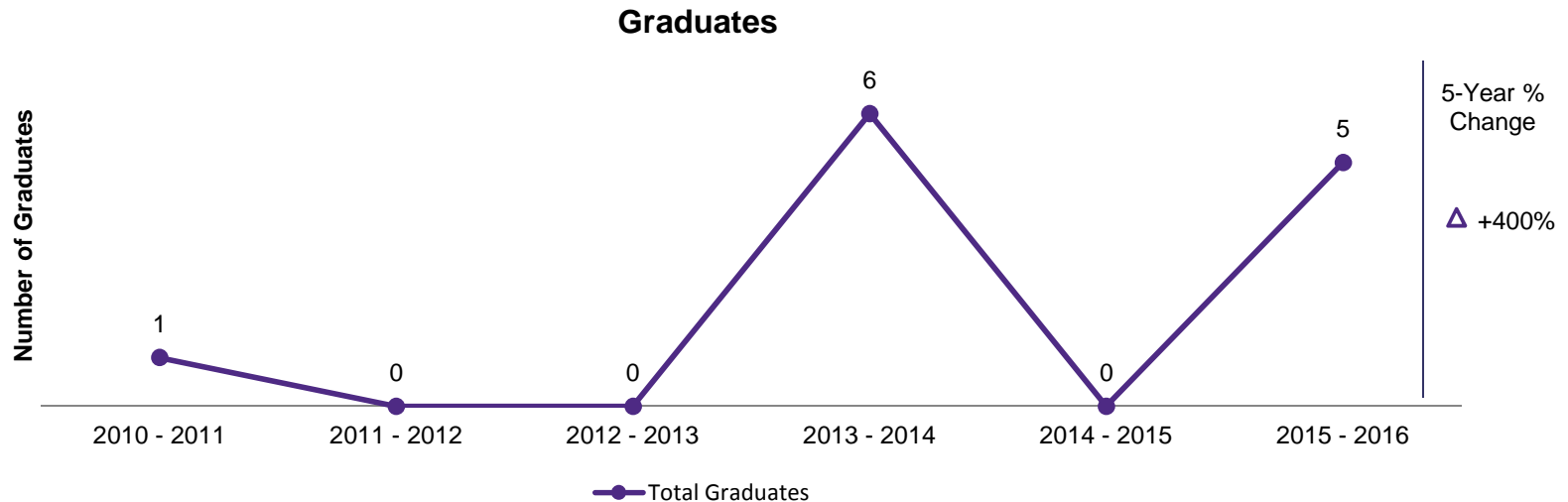
