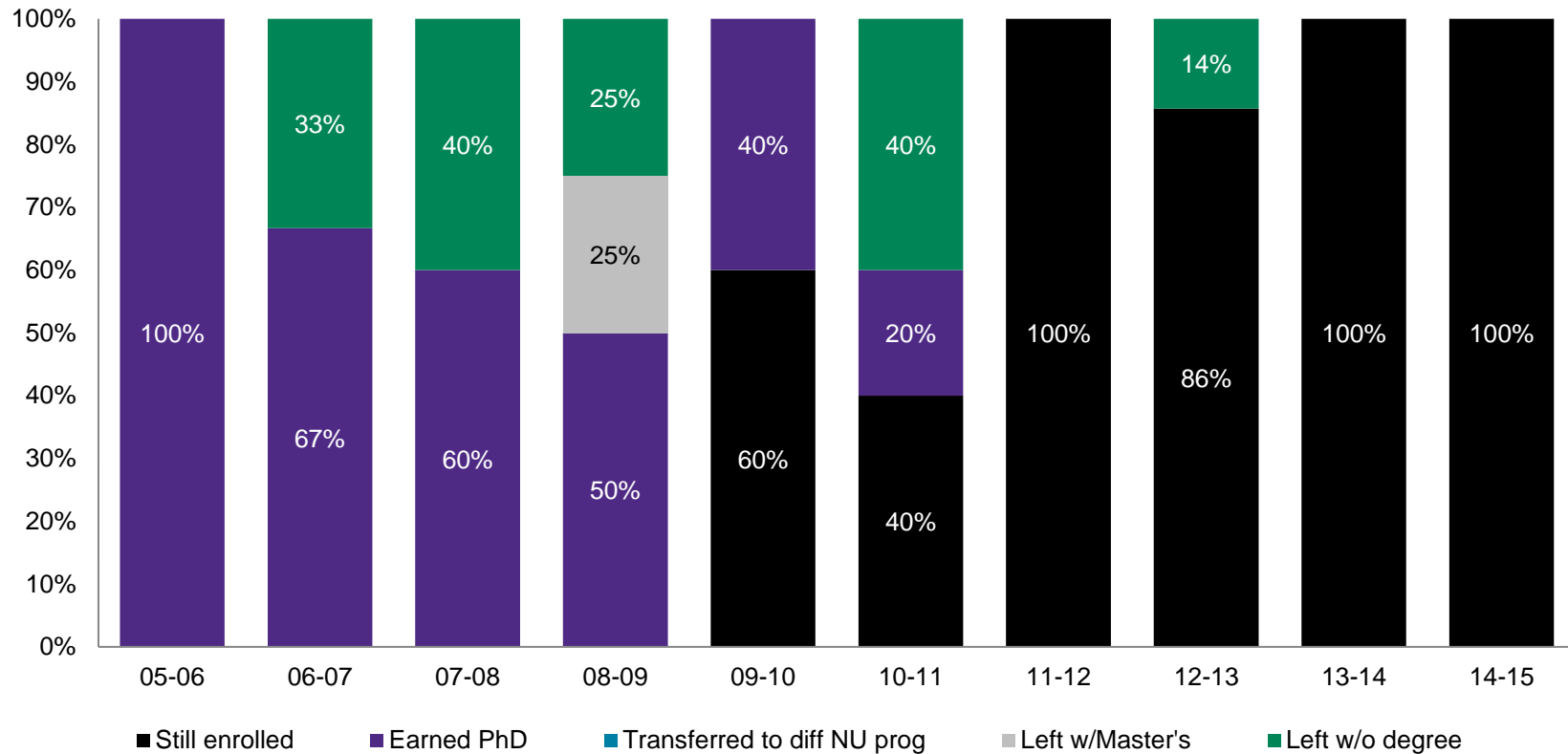

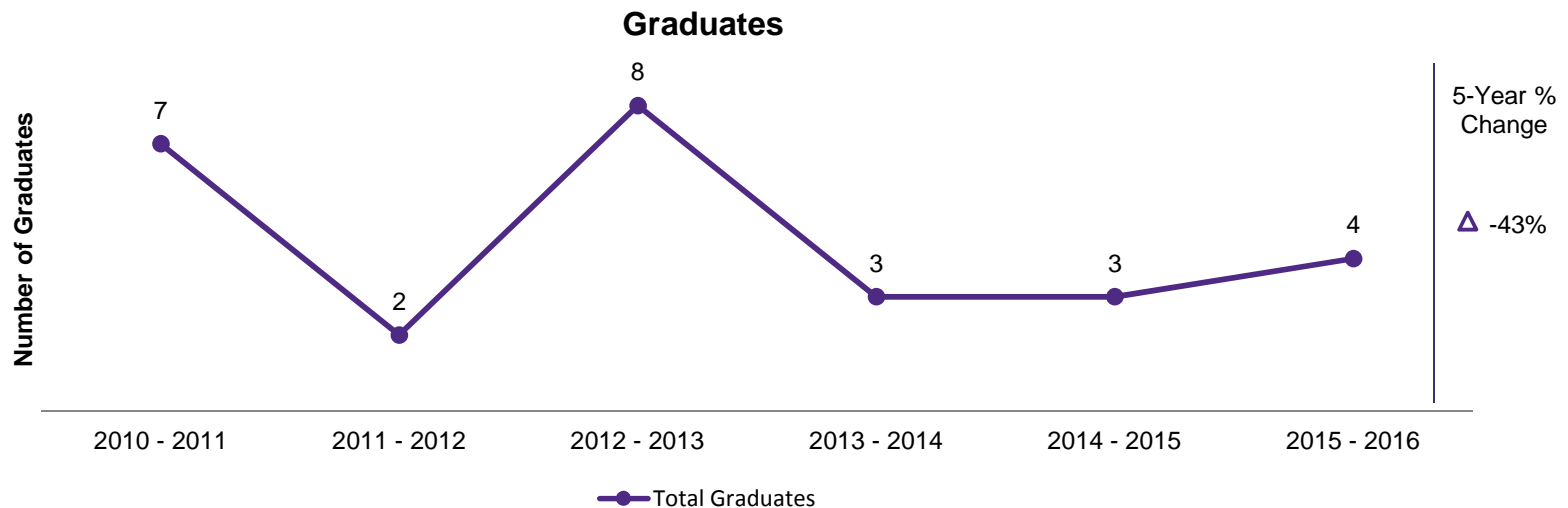
### Time-to-Degree
