

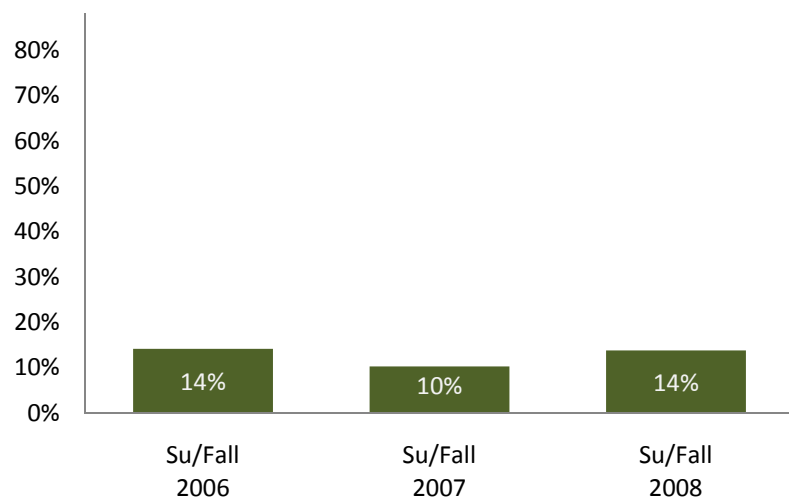

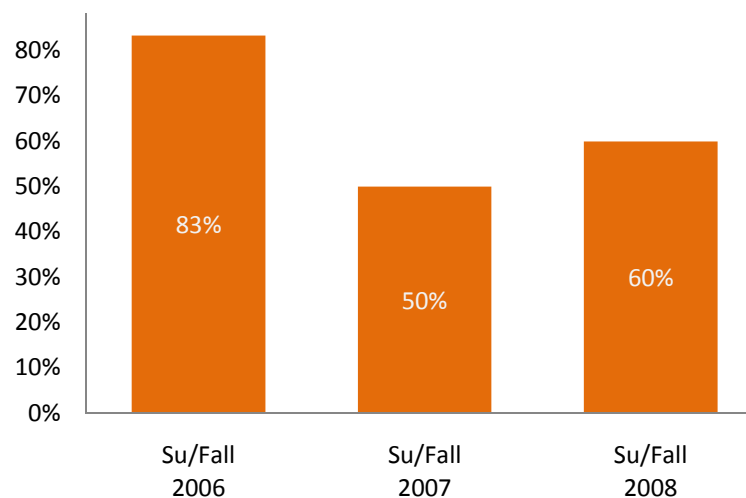

(Percentage of Admits Enrolled)



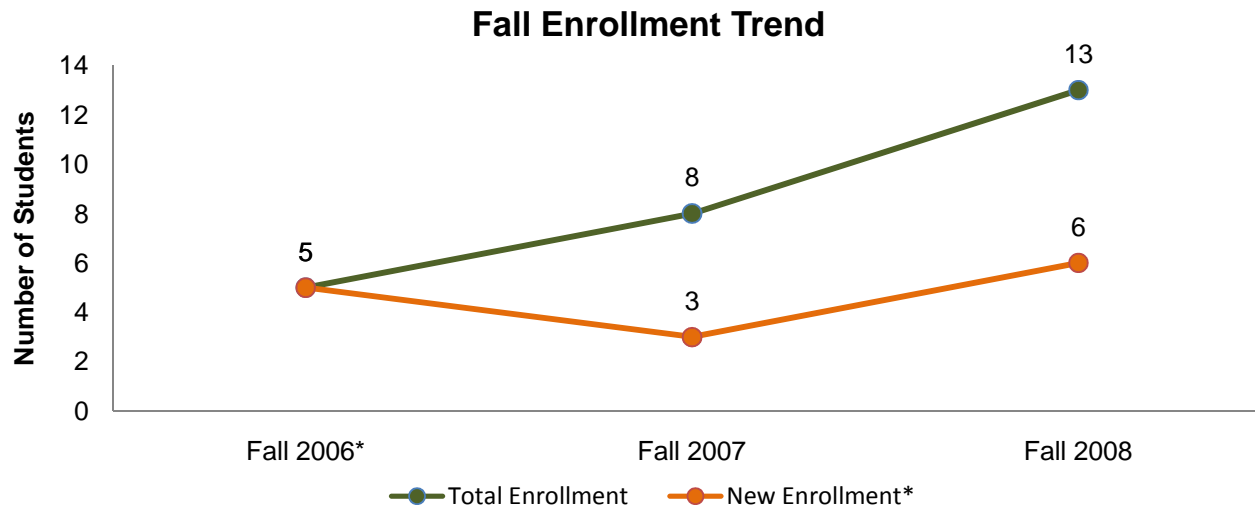
