

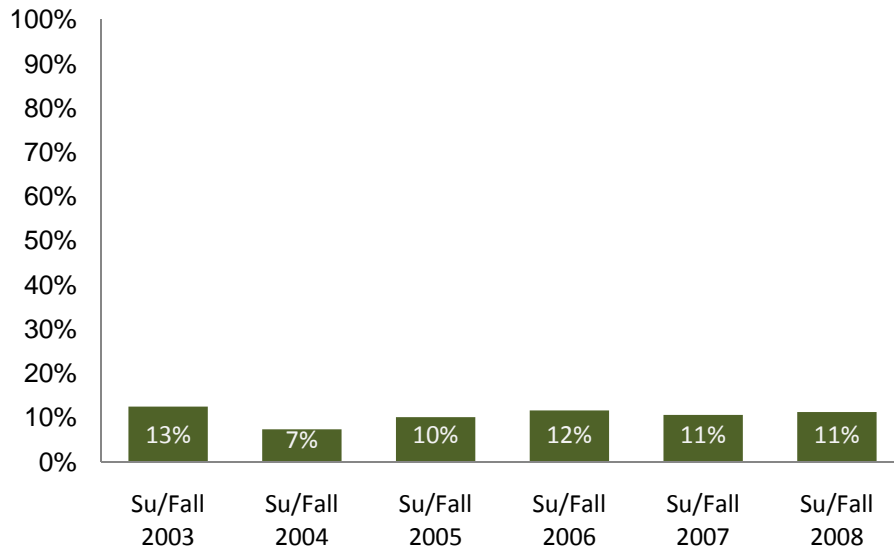

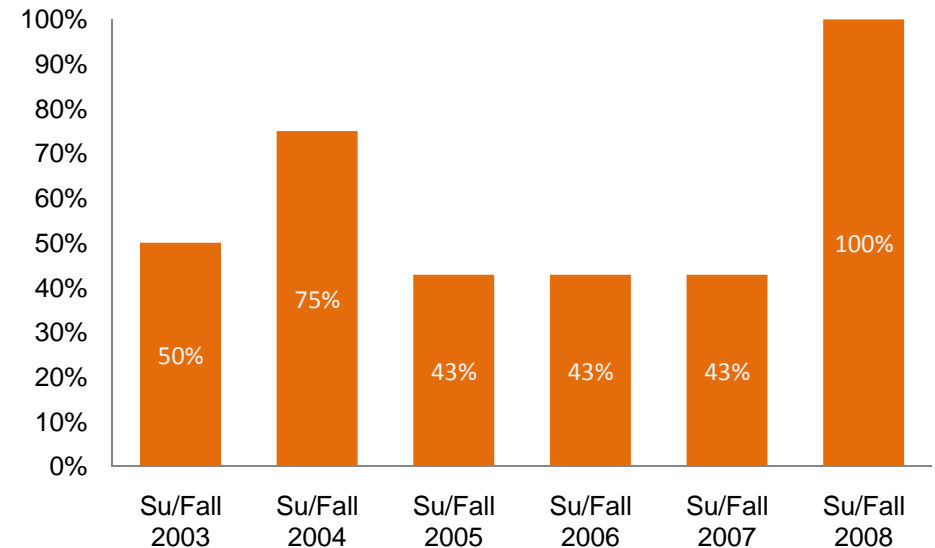

**Selectivity Average = 11%**

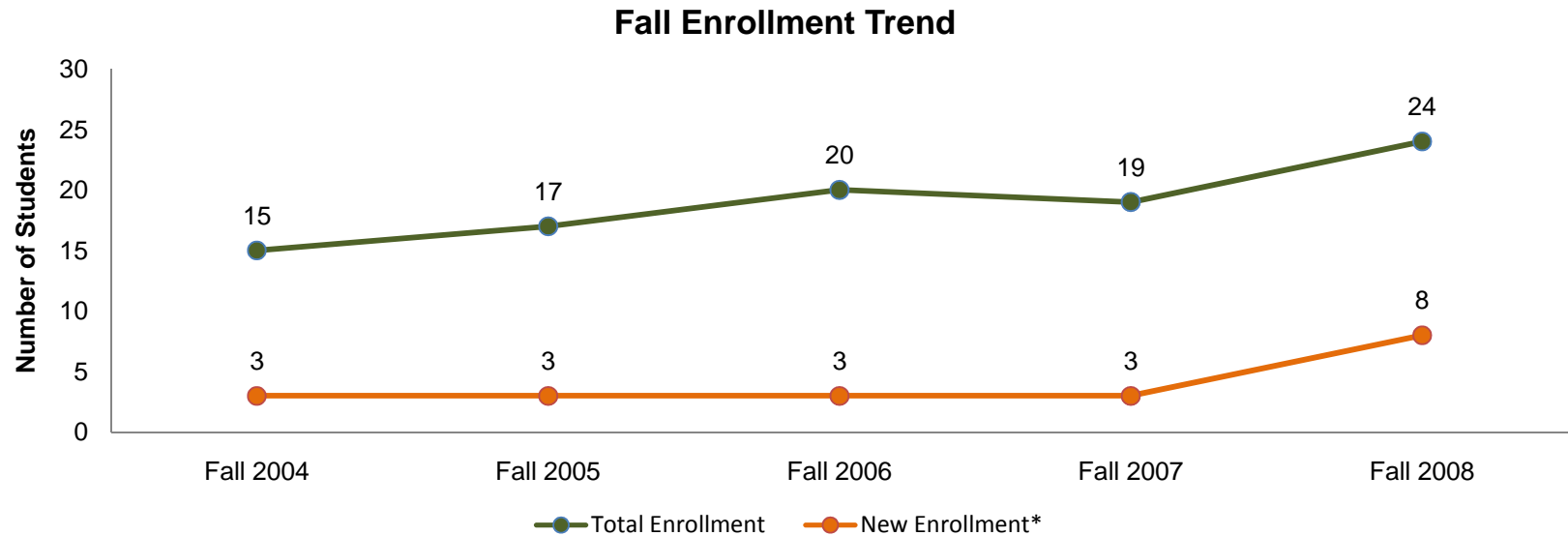
**Yield
