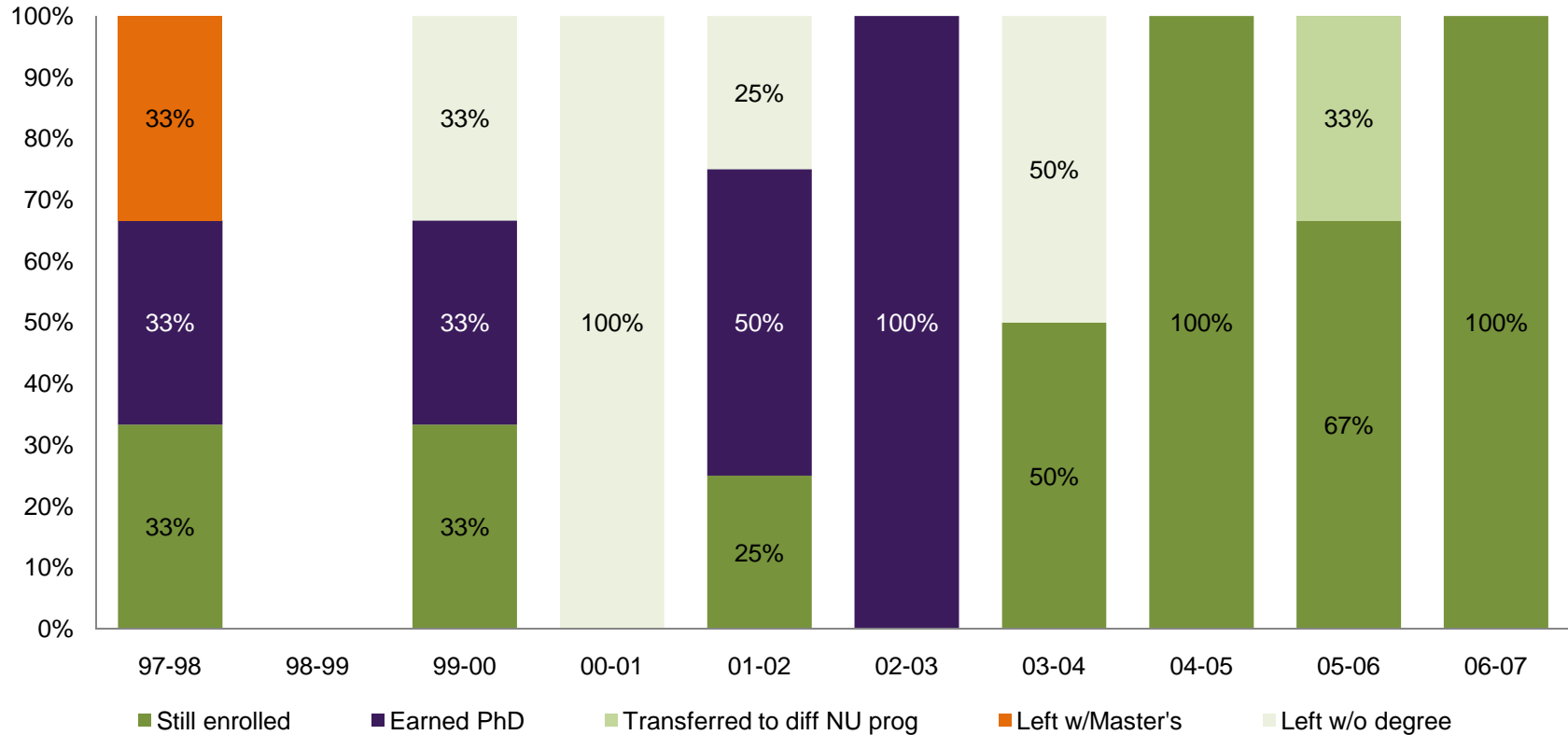

Students who transfer in from other NU graduate school programs are excluded.

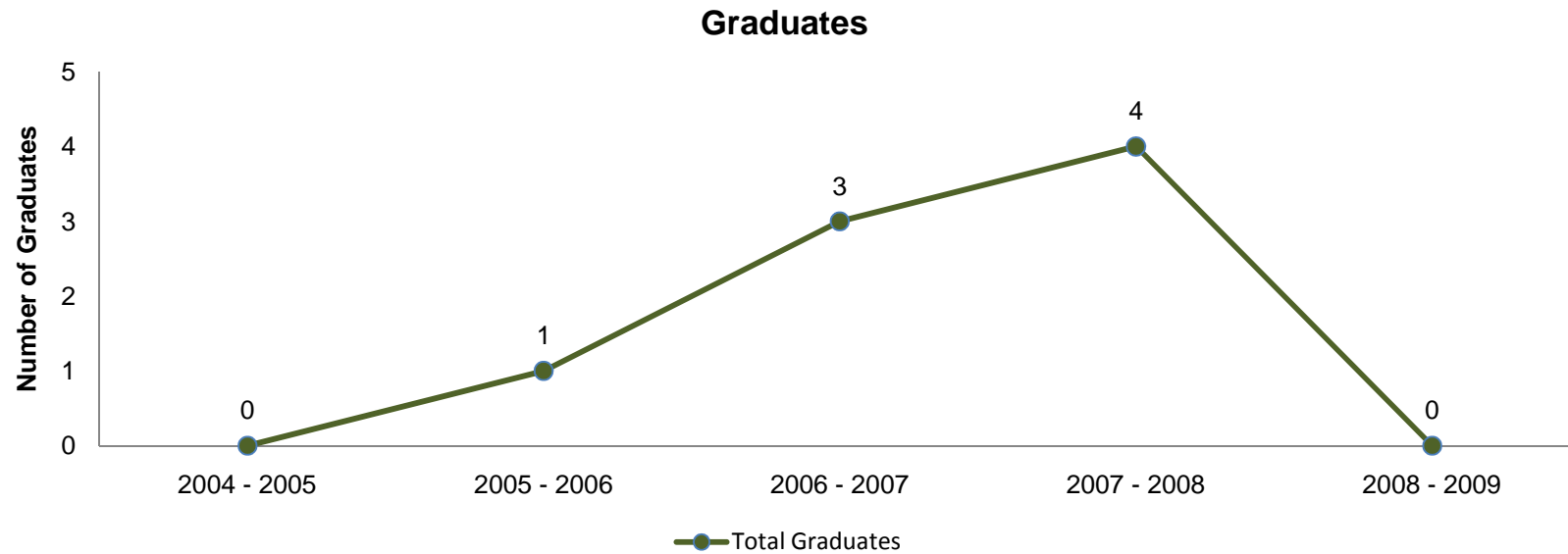
Time-to-Degree
