

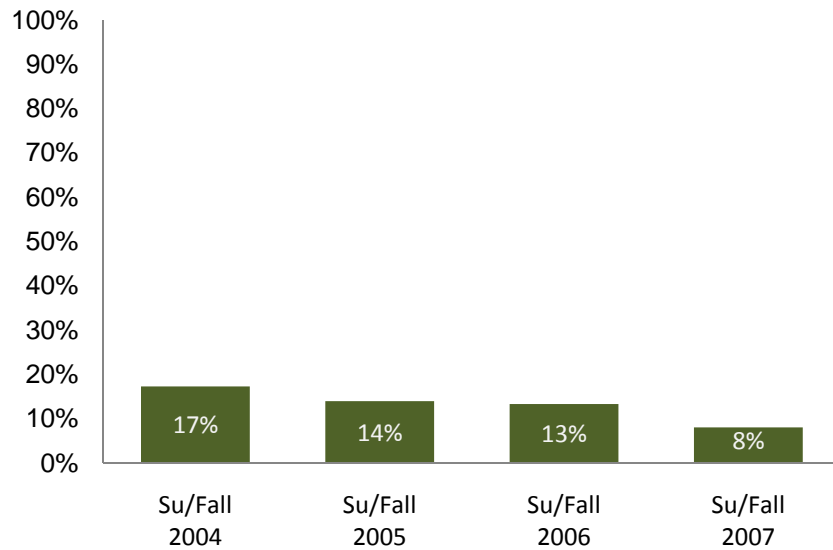

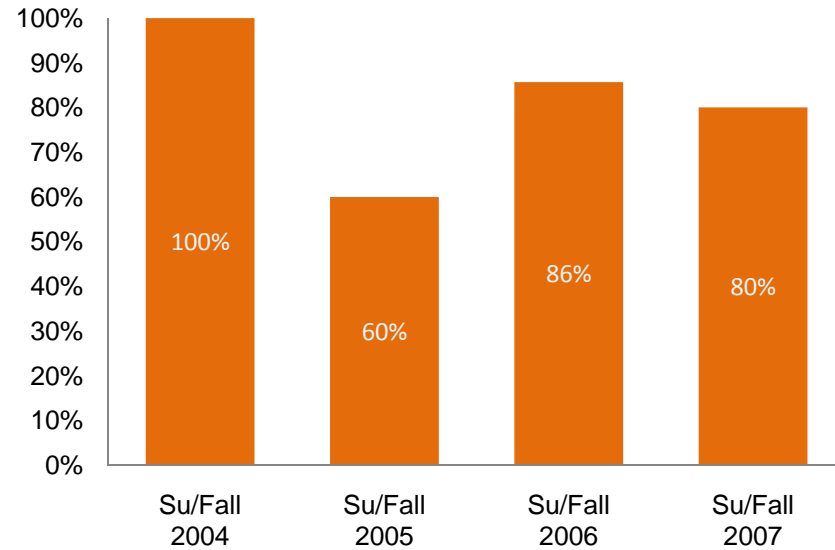

(Percentage of Admits Enrolled)**

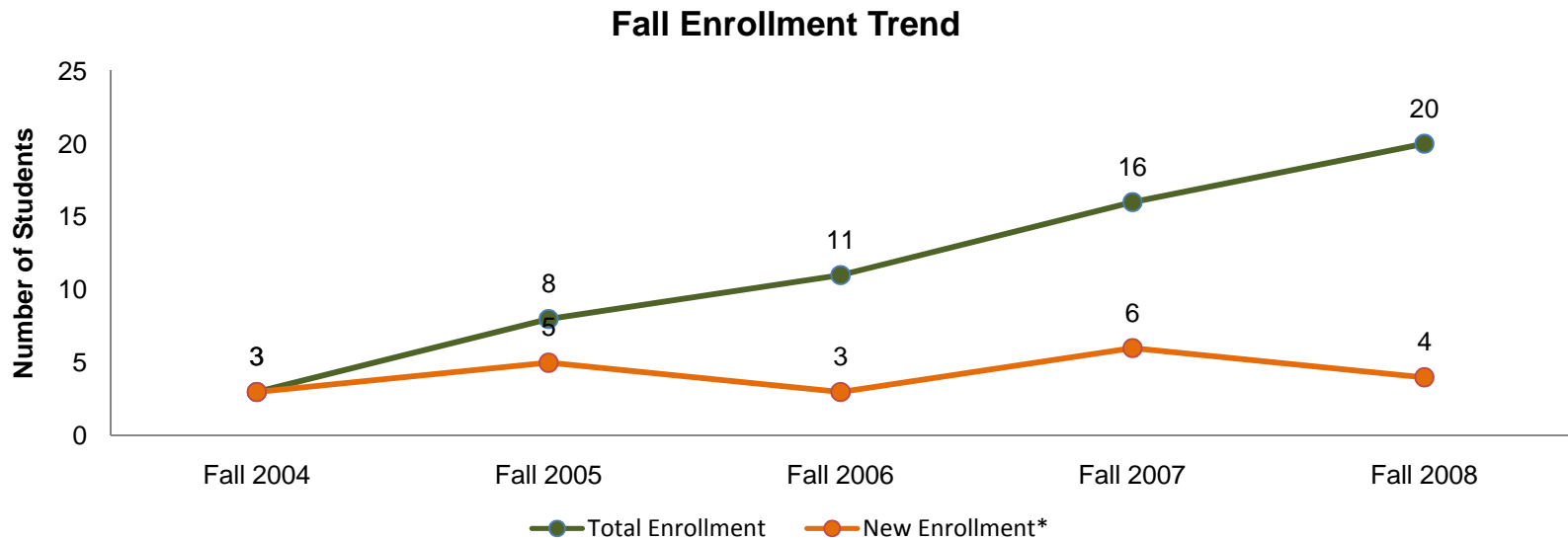


Yield Average = 84%
