

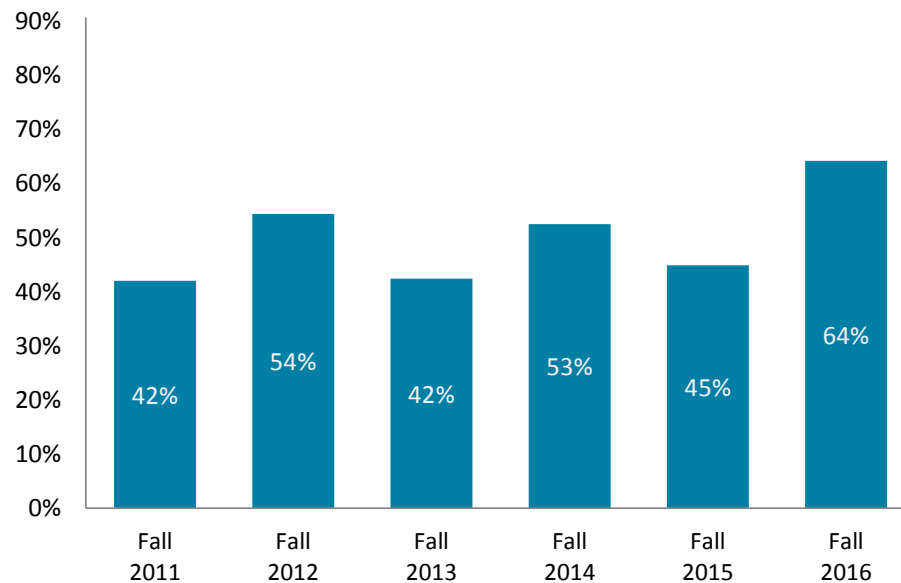

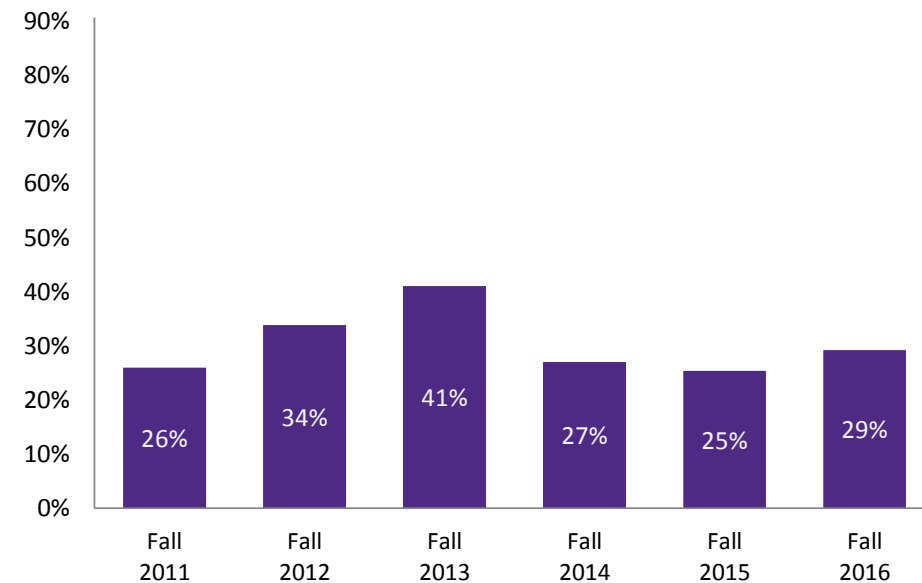

Selectivity Average = 51%

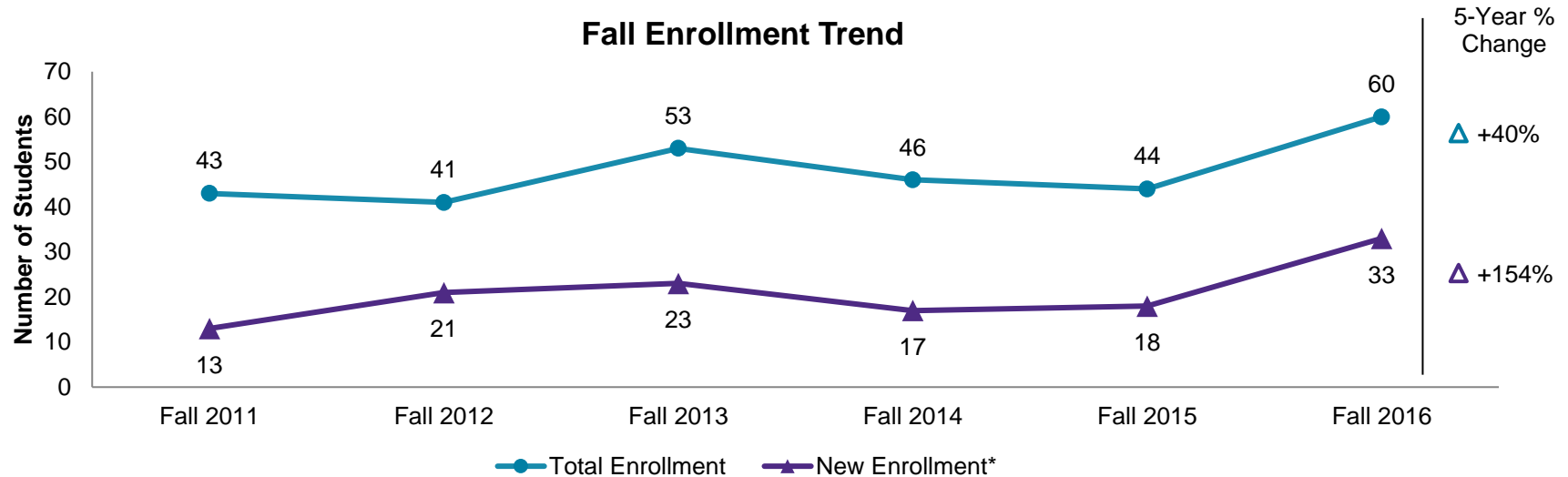
Yield
