

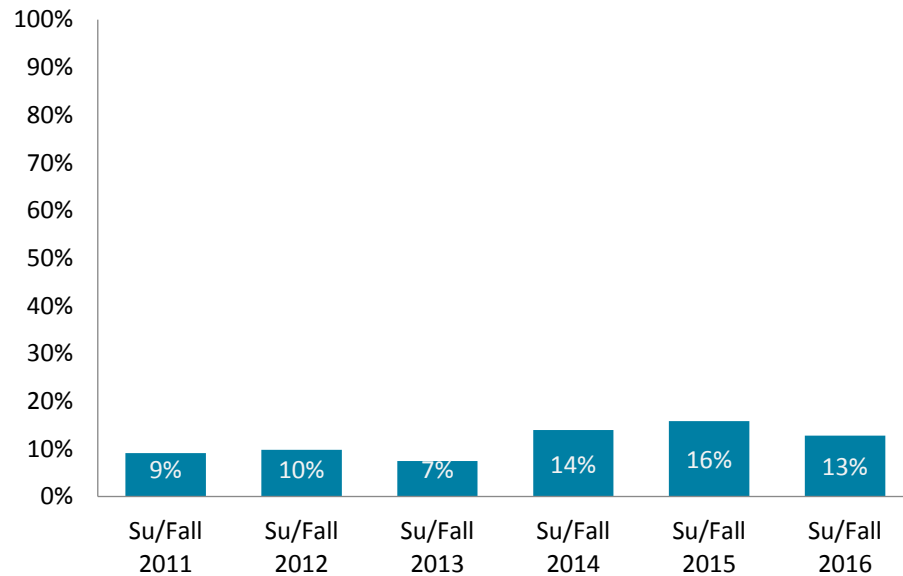

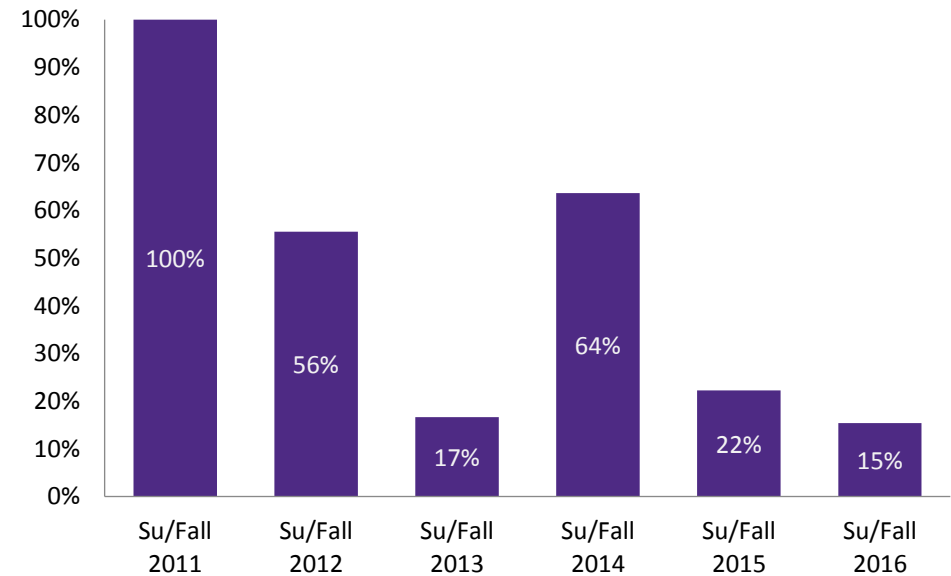

Selectivity Average = 11%

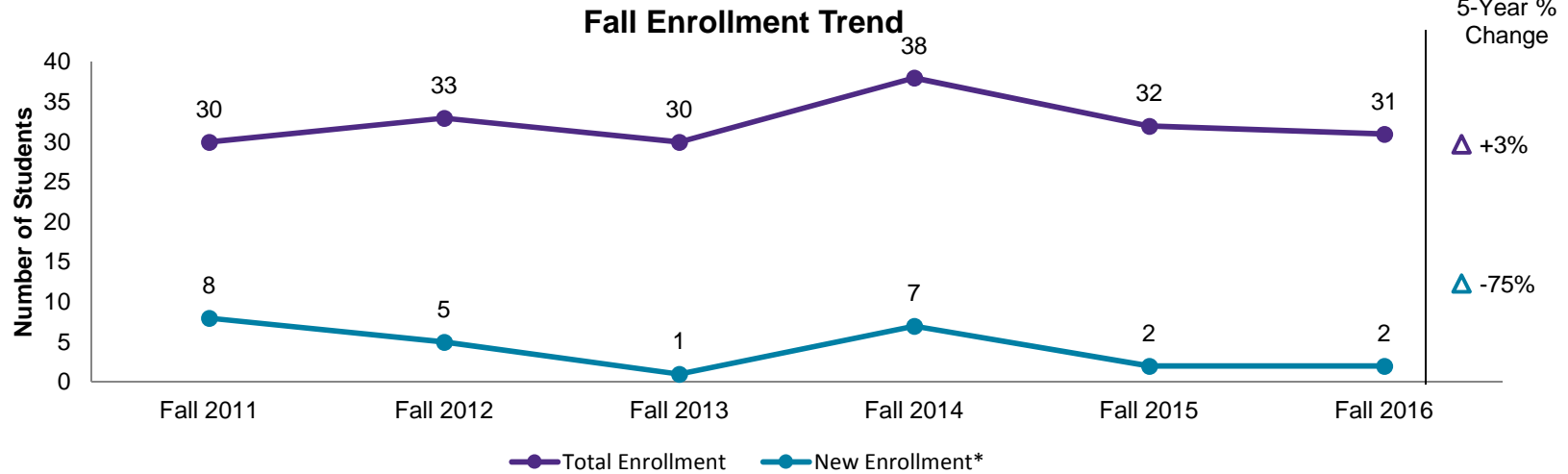
**Yield
