

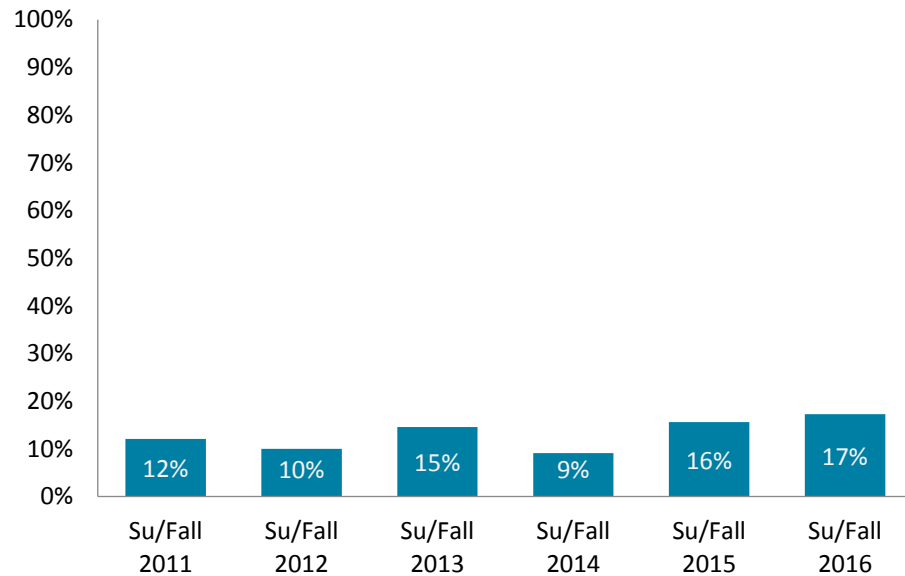

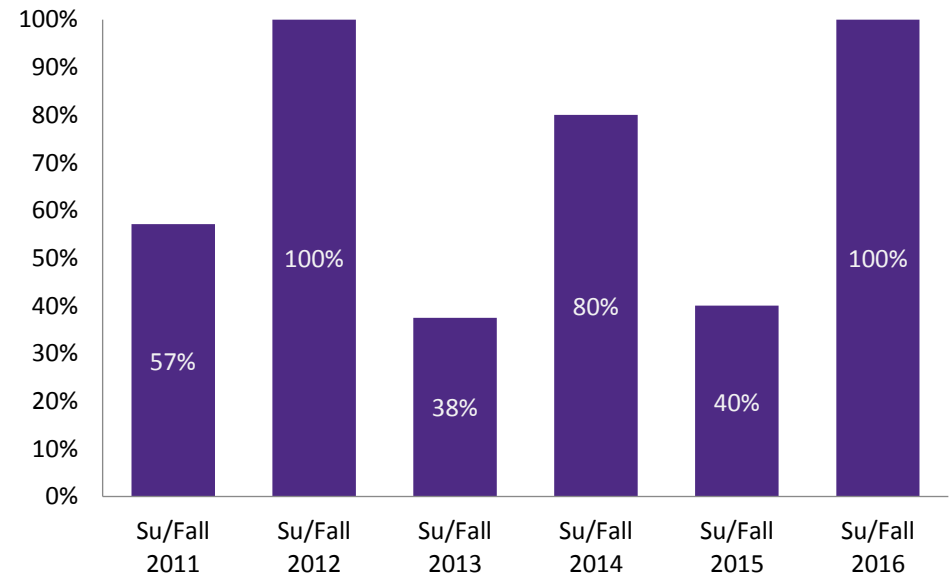

**Selectivity Average = 13%**

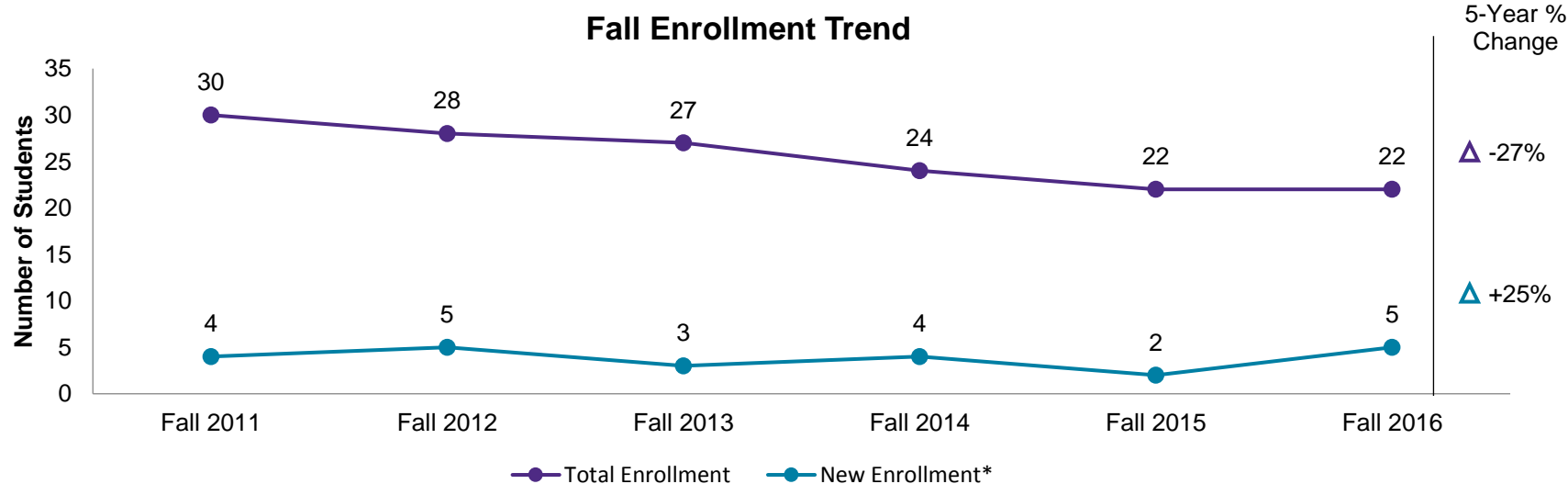
**Yield
