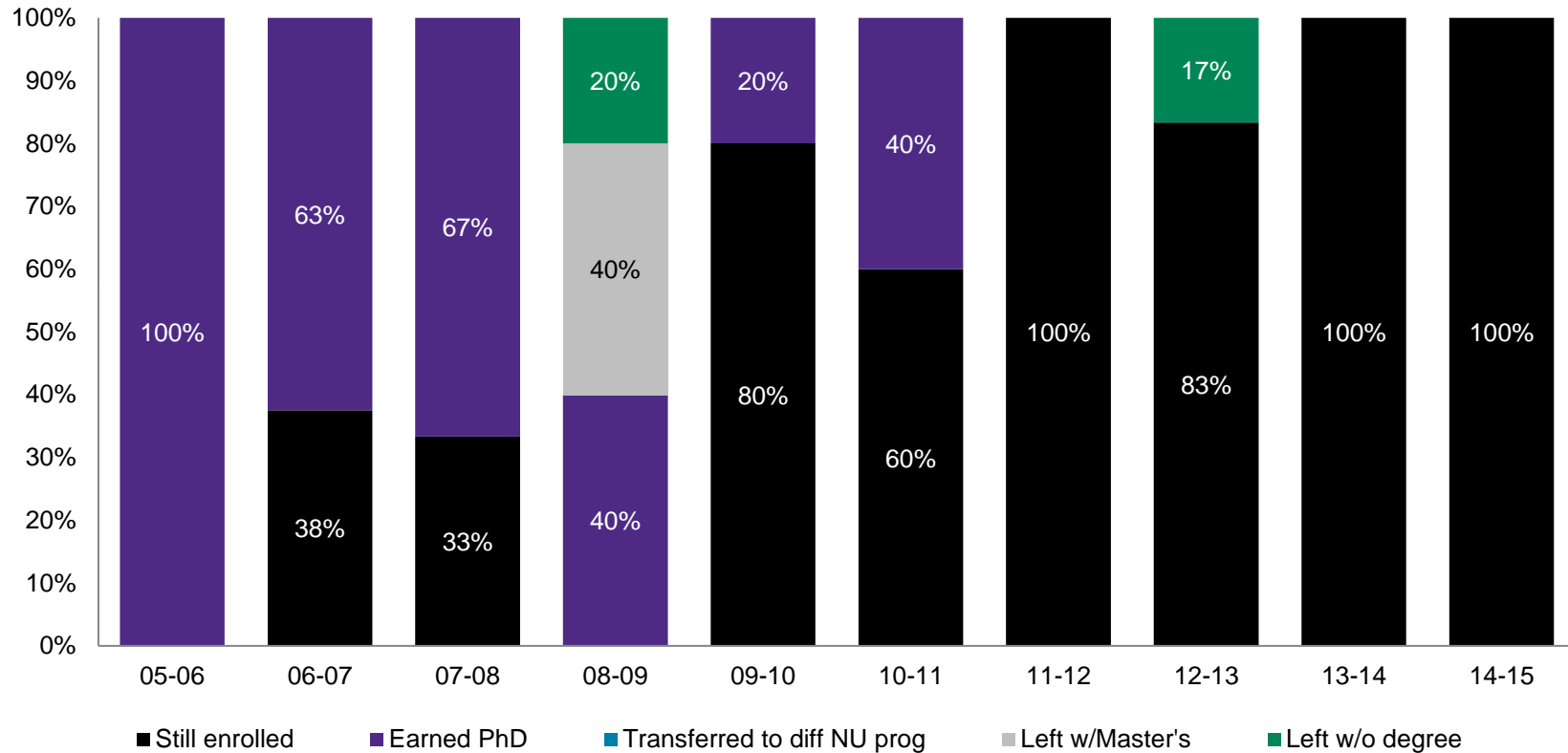

Applications for the PhD program in Screen Cultures were not accepted from 1998 - 1999.

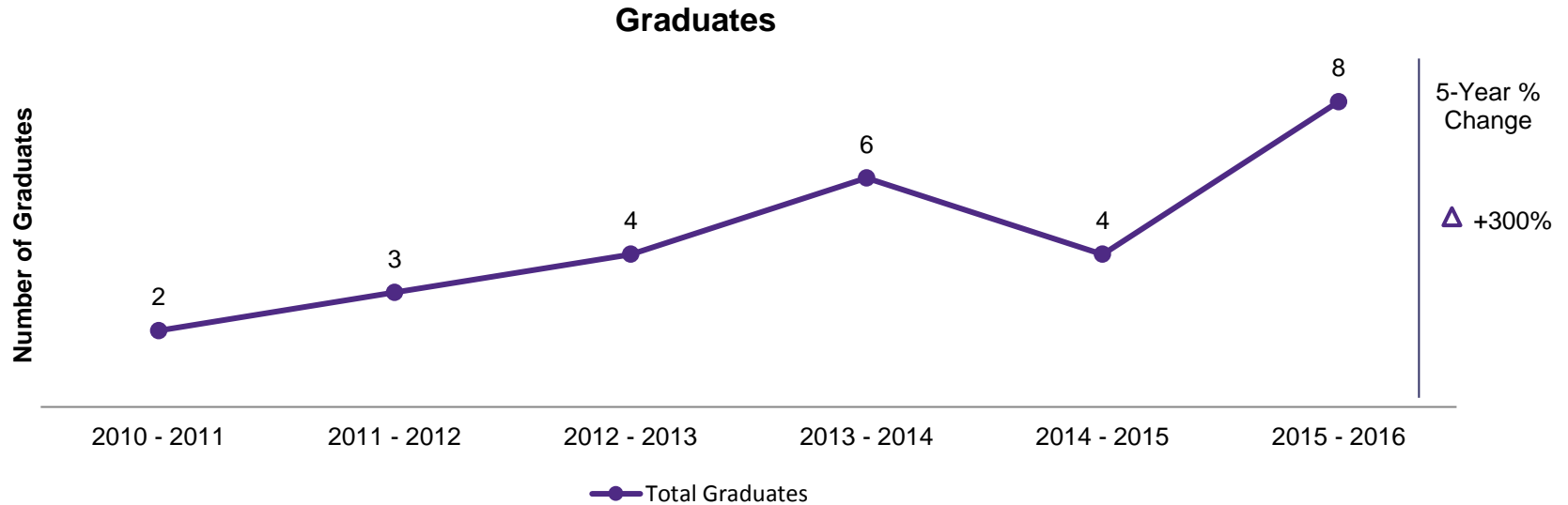
